15th STABILIZATION AND RECONSTRUCTION ORIENTATION COURSE

Turin (ITA), 5 - 16 June 2023

COURSE DESCRIPTION

1. Aim of the Course	To provide the participants with a wide knowledge of the Stabilization and Reconstruction Operations (S&R), to improve their understanding of complex post conflict operational scenarios and the diversified instruments for intervention and management (kinetic and non-kinetic) in compliance with the concept of “Comprehensive Approach”.
2. Course structure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Conferences and workshops held by high profile military experts and university professors; - Exchange of experiences on Stabilization and Reconstruction with foreign Centres of Excellence operating in the same field; - Analysis of case studies.
2. Duration	12 days (10 working days)
3. Course dates	05 – 16 June 2023

5. Eligible Participants	The course is open to Italian and foreign Officers (rank: Maj. and Lt. Col.) and to Italian and foreign Civilian Officials of the Ministries of Defence, personnel working in International Organizations, NGOs, Universities, private firms as well as professionals and graduate students interested in disciplines pertaining to Post Conflict activities.

9. Learning Objectives	<p>Upon completion of the course, attendees should be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - have a comprehensive view of all actors involved in S&R Operations; - consolidate the analysis and planning capabilities; - understand the rationale behind military operations; - improve their knowledge of the main geographical, political and economic factors; - improve their understanding of inter-agency cooperation.
10. Candidates Requirements	<p>Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Junior Executive Roles for civilians and rank Lt. Colonel/Major for military personnel; - Bachelor's Degree or equivalent; - very good level of English proficiency.
11. Admittance procedures	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Applications forms (electronic copy available on PCOSC web page) to be sent not later than 20th of April 2023, preferably via e-mail. - Military and civilian personnel belonging to MoDs (military/civilian personnel already included in the official admission list of the courses opened to foreign personnel - Academic Year 2022-2023), have to send applications through the Italian Military Attaché Office in his/her country or through his/her own national Military Attaché Office in Italy. - Other applicants can send applications through each organization they belong to or individually (for professionals or PHD students) to PCOSC.
12. Financial matters	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Upon confirmation of admittance to the Course, the tuition fee is to be paid at least a week before the beginning of the course by bank transfer to Difesa Servizi (Bank: Intesa San Paolo; IBAN: IT87L0306905020100000064355; BIC: BCITITMM) detailing in the description: NAME_SURNAME (of participant) Attendance of the 15th S&R Orientation Course SME06 at Comando per la Formazione e Scuola di Applicazione dell'Esercito, a.a. 2022 – 2023. A scanned copy of the bank transfer must be forwarded by email before the course starts. It should be noted that attendees for whom payment has not been made will not be admitted and, after three days from the beginning of the course, they will be definitively invited to leave the course and return back to their country. - Accommodation and meals charges are on individual basis or according to the official admission list of the courses opened to foreign personnel - Academic Year 2022-2023).
13. Course absences	Attendees who are absent more than one day of lesson will not get the Course Certificate. If the attendee does not conclude the course for any reason, the admission fee will not be returned to the Institution to which the attendee belongs or to the professional in case of personal admission.
14. Security Clearance	Not required
15. Visa Requirements	Requirements to be checked with participant's respective Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
16. Individual Medical Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - For EU Citizens and Citizens from Iceland, Norway, Liechtenstein and Switzerland: European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) or one of these models E106, E109, E120, E121 are required. - For non-EU Nationals: please see any current bilateral agreements between the participant's National Health Service and the Italian Health Service. In other cases, any participant's Health Insurance taking out is under his Nation's responsibility.
17. Transportation	Transportation from/to airport/railway stations upon coordination prior to arrival/departure. Military shuttle bus service is available from/to hotels booked via PCOSC.
18. Accommodation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Two hotels available at special rates (booking to be made by the attendee) - In case of booking cancellation or late arrival, participants have to inform our POCs (via e-mail or fax), NLT three working days prior to check-in (in case of failure to communicate such information, hotel fees may be applied).
19. Dress	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Military personnel: national duty uniform. - Civilians: jacket and tie. - During ice breaker dinner jacket and tie are required or ladies equivalent.
20. Meal service	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Meal service available at the School Mess if requested. - Meals to be booked day by day. Cost per meal is presently approx EUR 9,00.
21. Miscellaneous	At the end of the course attendees who have successfully completed the classes, will be presented with a Course Certificate.
