Major General of the Italian Army, he attended the Military Academy at Modena in 1987, ranking top officer on his course. He graduated from the University of Bologna in 1995, and the University of Trieste in 2005, with degrees in Mechanical Engineering and International Diplomatic Sciences, respectively. He attended the first year of the *Scuola di Guerra* (War College) in Italy in 1999, obtaining his Master's degree in Strategic Sciences. In 2003, he was awarded a Master's degree in Advanced Strategic Studies, while a student at the Joint Services Staff College in Madrid.

Major General Di Stasio has held various operational and staff positions, both in Italy and abroad (operations in Bosnia, Iraq, Somalia, and Lebanon) including: Strategic Advisor to the Somali Defence Minister under the EUTM (*European Union Training Mission*) - Somali mission; Liaison Officer at the French General Defence Staff in Paris; and, UNIFIL (*United Nations Interim Force In Lebanon*) Sector West Commander in Lebanon. In 2014, following his own research in this area, he established the 3rd Helicopter Regiment for Special Operations, "ALDEBARAN", in turn becoming the Regiment's first Commander.

On 27th June 2018, he was appointed Commander of "Sassari" Brigade in Sardinia, leading the Brigade's participation in operation Safe Street in Rome and later to the Unifil mission in Lebanon.

From November 2021 to April 2024 he was the Commander of the Army Aviation in Viterbo.

In April 2024 he has been appointed as Commander of the Army NCO Academy in Viterbo.

He continued his studies in Geopolitics, International Relations and Strategy, while continuing with military deployments to overseas operations in Bosnia, Iraq, Somalia, and Lebanon, and in 2020 he was appointed as Adjunct Professor, Faculty of Law at the University of Sassari, teaching on *International Cooperation and Resolution of Armed Conflicts in 2020-2021 and* as Adjunct Professor, Faculty of International Relations at the University of Viterbo, teaching on *International Organizations and Institutions for Security and Defense in 2022-2023*.

Married to Sanja, he has two sons, Matteo and Marco. He speaks English, French and Spanish.
